

# 2026 DOMESTIC SCHEDULE OF FEES

*Version Date: 28 May 2026*

This fee schedule sets out the tuition and non-tuition fees payable by domestic students for subjects undertaken during 2026. Unless otherwise stated, all subjects are delivered in accordance with the study period dates published on the [Ikon Important Dates](#) page. Domestic students who withdraw from a subject ahead of the relevant census date will not be charged a tuition fee for that subject. Some subjects will only be offered if there is sufficient student demand at the respective campus location.

## Future Study Periods

Ikon updates its fee schedule in September of each year for the following academic year. An update to this schedule will then be published for the following academic year. Fee increases are typically implemented each year to cover increased delivery costs. Course costs are expressed by Ikon as indicative only and subject to change, but once published, subject tuition and non-tuition fees remain in place for a 12-month period.

If a student enrolls in subjects that are due to be delivered beyond the current fee schedule (e.g., beyond 2026), the student should be aware that the tuition fees for that period will have their own schedule, applicable to that time period.
