

# 2023 International Scholarships

# 2023 Scholarship Offer

## TERMS AND CONDITIONS

- 2023 scholarship recipients must be enrolled and commence a relevant course in the 2023 academic year to be eligible for the scholarship. The scholarship cannot be deferred to commence in a future academic year.
- Scholarship recipients must maintain their enrolment in the course to continue to receive the scholarship.
- The scholarship provides a financial contribution towards course fees, and will be applied as a reduction of 25% to applicable subject fees for the duration of the course.
- Subject fees are published on the Schedule of Fees accessed via the Ikon website at [ikon.edu.au/fees/](http://ikon.edu.au/fees/). Please note that Ikon updates its course fees in around September of each year for the upcoming calendar year.
- The scholarship does not apply to any subjects where credit is granted in recognition of prior learning.
- The scholarship does not include non-tuition costs such as textbooks, equipment or field trips etc.
- The scholarship is non-transferable, non-refundable, cannot be used in conjunction with any other offers or taken as a cash amount.
- If a scholarship recipient receives more than one scholarship offer from Ikon the scholarship of greatest value will be awarded.
- The scholarship recipient must pay the balance of their subject fees in accordance with Ikon's standard payment terms. Failure to meet payment deadlines may forfeit the scholarship.
- All scholarship recipients are expected to maintain satisfactory academic progress. If a scholarship recipient is required to repeat a subject, the student is liable for the full subject fee for the repeated subject (ie. the 25% reduction will not apply). The subject fee will be charged at the subject fee applicable at the time of reenrolment for the failed subject.
- If a scholarship recipient withdraws from their course or suspends their study, the scholarship is automatically forfeited.
- If the recipient withdraws from a subject after the census date, the student is liable for the subject fee for the withdrawn subject.
- If a scholarship recipient is unable to meet the conditions of the scholarship due to illness, injury or other extenuating circumstances, the student may apply for special consideration. Where there are grounds for special consideration, Ikon may grant leave for one trimester. The scholarship will be reinstated on agreed return to study date. Failure to resume study at on the agreed date may forfeit the scholarship.
- Unless terminated earlier in accordance with these terms and conditions, the scholarship will end at the completion of the students course.
- Ikon may vary or terminate the scholarship where the scholarship recipient breaches the conditions of the scholarship or enrolment. This may include, but is not limited to, poor academic performance, poor attendance, misconduct, withdrawal or cancellation of enrolment, breaches to the student code of conduct, providing false or misleading information during the admission process that results in the scholarship being awarded, failure to pay the balance of subject fees by the relevant deadline, or accepting an alternative scholarship administered by Ikon. The recipient may be required to repay any scholarship benefits that they were not entitled to within fourteen days of the written notice of termination.
- Scholarship recipients agree to be ambassadors of Ikon and assist with positive promotion of Ikon and the course including contributing to social media, blogs, newsletters etc. and attendance at events such as Orientation, Open Days and other reasonable promotional activities.
- Eligible recipients must accept the scholarship offer by signing the Scholarship Acceptance Declaration and, in doing so, agree to abide by the terms and conditions of the 2023 Scholarship.
- The scholarship will not commence until a completed Scholarship Acceptance Declaration has been received by Ikon. A Scholarship Acceptance Declaration is determined complete only when all conditions have been accepted and the declaration has been signed.
- Ikon reserves the right to make changes to the scholarship and/or these terms and conditions without notice. All decisions made by Ikon in relation to the scholarship are final. There is no right of appeal.
