

EARLY CHILDHOOD EDUCATION SCHOLARSHIP OFFER



TERMS & CONDITIONS

- Scholarship recipients must be enrolled in the Diploma or Bachelor of Early Childhood Education and commence in the 2022 academic year to be eligible for the Early Childhood Education Scholarship. The scholarship cannot be deferred to commence in a future academic year.
- Scholarship recipients must maintain their enrolment in the Diploma or Bachelor of Early Childhood Education to continue to receive the scholarship.
- The scholarship value is based on a financial contribution towards course fees across the duration of the course:
 - Domestic Diploma students will receive a financial contribution up to \$10,080.00 (based on 2022 Indicative Course Fees of \$28,800)
 - Domestic Bachelor students will receive a financial contribution up to \$20,160.00 (based on 2022 Indicative Course Fees of \$28,800)
 - International Diploma students will receive a financial contribution up to \$12,600.00 (based on 2022 Indicative Course Fees of \$36,000)
 - International Bachelor students will receive a financial contribution up to \$25,200 (based on 2022 Indicative Course Fees of \$72,000)
- The scholarship value refers to full course fees as published on the Schedule of Fees accessed via the website at ikon.edu.au/fees/. It excludes discounts and/or other offers.
- The scholarship will be applied as a reduction of the subject fees and will be calculated on the number of subjects enrolled in during each trimester (study load):
- The scholarship does not apply to any subjects where credit is granted in recognition of prior of learning.
- The scholarship does not include learning associated costs such as textbooks, equipment or fieldtrips etc.
- The scholarship is non-transferrable, non-refundable, cannot be used in conjunction with any other offers and cannot be taken as a cash amount.
- If a scholarship recipient receives more than one scholarship offer from Ikon, only the scholarship of greatest value will be awarded.
- The scholarship recipient must pay the balance of their subject fees. The balance will be charged at the subject fee applicable at the time of enrolment. Failure to meet payment deadlines may forfeit the scholarship.
- All scholarship recipients are expected to maintain satisfactory academic progress. If a scholarship recipient is required to repeat a subject, the student is liable for the full subject fee for the repeated subject. The subject fee will be charged at the subject fee applicable at the time of re-enrolment for the failed subject.
- If a scholarship recipient withdraws from their course, they forfeit the scholarship. If the recipient withdraws after census date, the student is liable for the subject fees for the withdrawn subjects applicable at the time of withdrawal.
- The scholarship does not provide for the suspension of enrolment to take a leave of absence from study.
- If a scholarship recipient is unable to meet the conditions of the scholarship due to illness, injury or other extenuating circumstances, the student may apply for special consideration. Where there are grounds for special consideration, Ikon may grant leave for one trimester. The scholarship will be reinstated on agreed return to study date. Failure to resume study at on the agreed date may forfeit the scholarship.
- Unless terminated earlier, the scholarship will end when the total financial contribution has been applied.
- Ikon may vary or terminate the scholarship where the scholarship recipient breaches the conditions of the scholarship or enrolment. This may include, but is not limited to, poor academic performance, poor attendance, misconduct, withdrawal or cancellation of enrolment, breaches to the student code of conduct, providing false or misleading information during the admission process that results in the scholarship being awarded, failure to pay the balance of subject fees by the trimester deadline, accepting an alternative scholarship administered by Ikon, or an incorrect scholarship offer was made as determined by Ikon in its sole discretion. The recipient may be required to repay any scholarship benefits that they were not entitled to within fourteen days of the written notice of termination.
- Scholarship recipients agree to be ambassadors of Ikon and assist with the positive promotion of the Diploma or Bachelor of Early Childhood Education including contributing to social media, blogs, newsletter etc. and attendance at events such as Orientation, Open Days and other reasonable promotional activities. Accepting the terms and conditions of the scholarship provides the scholarship recipient's consent to be used for promotional purposes.
- Eligible recipients must accept the scholarship offer by signing the Scholarship Acceptance Declaration and, in doing so, agree to abide by the terms and conditions of the Early Childhood Education Scholarship offered by Proteus Technologies Pty Ltd (trading as Ikon Institute of Australia).
- The scholarship will not commence until a completed Scholarship Acceptance Declaration has been received by Ikon. A Scholarship Acceptance Declaration is determined complete only when all conditions have been accepted and the declaration signed.
- Scholarships are limited in number and available until the quota for this scholarship has been reached.
- All decisions in relation to scholarship are final. There is no right of appeal if unsuccessful, varied or terminated.
